MAINTAINING QUALIFICATION REQUIREMENTS FOR CONTINUED VALIDITY OF PILOT LICENCES

EFFECTIVE DATE: 01 July 2017

APPLICABILITY: Holders of Bahraini Pilot License

PURPOSE:

This Aeronautical Circular is issued to inform Bahraini Pilot License holders about the requirements in regards to maintaining qualification requirements for continued validity of Pilot Licences.

REQUIREMENTS:

The Pilot license issued by Bahrain CAA is generally valid for five (5) years. The continued validity of license as well as right to exercise privileges of such license is dependent on, but not limited to, validity of the ratings contained therein, valid medical certificate in accordance with ANTR-FCL 3.105, continued qualification with reference to the use of radiotelephony and a valid language proficiency endorsement in accordance with ANTR-FCL 1.010(a)(4). Failure of meeting one or more of these requirements would render the holder ineligible to exercise privileges of subject license. In view of the same, it is the responsibility of the license holder as well as operations department of the air operator to ensure that such requirements are met with prior to exercising the privileges of the license.

In view of the same, it is obligatory that as and when one or more of the requirements for continued validity of License has been rendered invalid/ lapsed, the operations department of the air operator shall take necessary corrective action. In addition, details in regards to such instances shall be forwarded to the "Chief Aviation Permits and Licensing" in the form of a Six Monthly report for the purpose of review and records. Such reports shall also contain details of action taken including de-rostering of pilots if required to do so.
